This bill amends the Acupuncture Registration Act (Act 2 of 1986) to change the requirement from “registration” to “license”.

The Acupuncture Registration Act (Act 2 of 1986) regulates the practice of acupuncture in Pennsylvania. The act requires acupuncturists to be registered with either the State Board of Medicine or the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
